2017 Year in Review!

- Held over 40 sessions with women who were post abortive, pregnant, experiencing domestic violence and other traumas.
- Ran two retreats which facilitated the healing of over 7 post abortive women.
- Supplied over a dozen single mother headed families with groceries, material supplies, appliances, furniture and household items.
- Provided housing directly for three pregnant moms and schooling for two teenagers at risk.
- Hosted post abortion healing training for volunteers which included a minister from Barbados.
- Co-Hosted and spoke at two regional conferences on life and family issues with the World Congress of Families and local NGO's in Antigua & Barbuda and St Lucia.
